**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE OF BENTLEYVILLE TO
CONDUCT AN ADVISORY ELECTION ON NOVEMBER 6, 2012, POSING A
QUESTION TO THE ELECTORS AS TO WHETHER THE VILLAGE OF
BENTLEYVILLE SHOULD JOIN A JOINT RECREATIONAL DISTRICT AND
PARTICIPATE IN THE CHAGRIN VALLEY RECREATION EXPANSION AND
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, Council for the Village of Bentleyville desires to submit to the electors at the November 6, 2012, election the question of whether the Village should join a joint recreational district and participate in the Chagrin Valley Recreation Expansion.

WHEREAS, Council for the Village of Bentleyville has the authority to conduct such an advisory election pursuant to the "Home Rule" powers granted to the Village by Article XVIII of the Ohio Constitution.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE
OF BENTLEYVILLE, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO:**

Section 1: Council hereby directs that the question as to whether the Village should join a joint recreational district and participate in the Chagrin Valley Recreation Expansion shall be forwarded to the Cuyahoga County Board of Elections for a vote of the Electors at the November 6, 2012, election.

Section 2: The Board of Elections of Cuyahoga County is hereby directed to provide for the voting upon the following question.

"Shall the Village of Bentleyville join a joint recreational district and participate in the Chagrin Valley Recreation Expansion".

Each voter shall indicate his/her vote by marking the ballot in the manner prescribed by the Board of Elections of Cuyahoga County.

Section 3: The Fiscal Officer is hereby directed to provide newspaper notice in accordance with the requirements of the Ohio Revised Code and to certify a copy of this Ordinance to the Board of Elections of Cuyahoga County.

Section 4: The Fiscal Officer is hereby authorized and directed to appropriate from the General Fund a sum sufficient to pay the cost of publishing said notice referred to in Section 3.

Section 5:

It is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees or subcommittees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 6:

This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Village of Bentleyville, and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to forward the proposed measure to the Cuyahoga County Board of Elections for presentation to the electors of the November 6, 2012, general election and, therefore, shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage.
