AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH CARRON ASPHALT PAVING, INC. IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$187,541.75 FOR THE 2013 ROAD PROGRAM AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, CARRON ASPHALT PAVING, INC. has submitted a bid to the Village for the 2013 Road Program in an amount not to exceed \$187,541.75; and

WHEREAS, Council has determined that CARRON ASPHALT PAVING, INC. is the lowest and best bidder for the project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Bentleyville, Ohio, County of Cuyahoga, State of Ohio, that:


Section 1. The Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with CARRON ASPHALT PAVING, INC. in an amount not to exceed One Hundred Eighty Seven Thousand Five Hundred Forty One Dollars and 75/100 (\$187,541.75) for the 2013 Road Program.

Section 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including the applicable sections of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, or safety of the inhabitants of the Village and for the further reason that the Village want to enter into a contract with Carron Asphalt Paving, Inc. as soon as possible.




