
**AN ORDINANCE CREATING THE POSITION OF SERVICE DIRECTOR,  
ESTABLISHING COMPENSATION, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.  
(SECOND READING)**

WHEREAS, the Village of Bentleyville wants to create the position of Service Director to oversee and run the service department.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Bentleyville, County of Cuyahoga, State of Ohio, that:


- Section 1.** Council for the Village of Bentleyville hereby creates the position of Service Director which will be either a part-time or full-time position as determined by the Mayor and confirmed by Council.
- Section 2.** The salary for the Service Director shall be determined by the Mayor and confirmed by Council during the budget process.
- Section 3.** It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including the applicable sections of the Ohio Revised Code.
- Section 4.** This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the public peace, health, or safety of the inhabitants of the Village and for the further reason that the Village of Bentleyville wants to immediately hire a service director to operate the service department. This Ordinance shall, therefore, take effect and be in full force immediately from and after the date of its passage and approval.
